## 5-3-1 Strategy

## What

The 5-3-1 strategy is a think-pair-share summarization activity. Students generate their thoughts and then work with group members to summarize their thoughts into a single word.

## Why

Summarization is one of the most vital concepts any skilled reader can utilize. Summarization is an important literacy goal because it helps students understand what has been read.

## How

- 1. On their own, students think of <u>5</u> words or phrases related to what they learned (ex. from a book, an article, from a unit or lesson).
- 2. At their table, students share their ideas and pick  $\underline{3}$  key ideas that best represent the group.
- 3. Then, the group narrows the ideas to  $\underline{1}$  word that captures the essence of the  $\underline{3}$  key ideas.
- 4. Each group shares their <u>1</u> word with the whole group.
