P-Q-R-S-T

This easy-to-remember strategy is used for expository reading and is grounded in sound practices for reading comprehension.

- <u>P</u> **Preview** the text to identify the main parts
- **Q** Develop *questions* that you want to answer based on the text
- **R Read** the material, twice if needed
- **S State** the central idea or theme
- <u>T</u> **Test** yourself by answering questions or teach the material to someone else
