

## P-Q-R-S-T

This easy-to-remember strategy is used for expository reading and is grounded in sound practices for reading comprehension.

P - **Preview** the text to identify the main parts

Q - Develop **questions** that you want to answer based on the text

R - **Read** the material, twice if needed

S - **State** the central idea or theme

T - **Test** yourself by answering questions or teach the material to someone else
